

Topic >> Jesus Christ “The Lion of the Tribe of Juda”

What a vivid contrast we see in Jesus 1st & 2nd coming. **Matthew 25:31 KJV** “When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: **He is coming to Judge the ungodly and to rule on earth**

***In His first coming** He was wrapped in swaddling clothes. ***In His second coming He will be clothed royally in a robe dipped in blood.** ***In His first coming** He was surrounded by cattle and common people. ***In His second coming He will be accompanied by the massive armies of heaven.** ***In His first coming** the door of the inn was closed to Him. ***In His second coming the door of the heavens will be opened to Him.** ***In His first coming** His voice was the tiny cry of a baby. ***In His second coming - His voice will thunder as the sound of many waters.**



What Takes Place? - When Jesus Christ Arrives on the Mount of Olives

(The Bible says riding on a white horse) The white color represents purity or victory, for this rider is holy and goes forth to be the triumphant conqueror. During ancient times, victorious Roman generals entered their conquered cities in chariots drawn by white horses. The entire setting implies victory over Christ’s enemies. As such, the word white indicates triumph, a successful war. **Rev19:11 KJV** “And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war”

After Jesus gave His disciples the Great Commission, “he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight” (**Acts 1:9**). As the disciples stood there, gazing after the Lord, two angels appeared and told them, “This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven” (**Acts 1:11**). A cloud is mentioned at His ascension, and clouds are mentioned at His return. “And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: **KING Of KINGS And LORD Of LORDS**” (**Rev 19:16**). It’s a false allusion within humanity to think that a sinful human can bring a lasting peace on planet earth. For thousands of years mankind has tried every experiment within the mind of humanity to bring about a righteous and good government that will bring peace on this earth - all have totally failed! There is major corruption and deceit within the administrations of every government that exists on this earth. Why? Because every human on earth is a natural born sinner. We are fooling ourselves when we think some human leader can solve the problems of any nation, much less the entire world. **When the Lord Jesus Christ comes He will defeat Satan, the Antichrist, the false Prophet, and all the other world leaders who are fighting against Him.** Thus, He will set up His earthly kingdom. At that time Jesus Christ will take total control of His earth and there will be a good, wise, and righteous government (for the first time since the world began) that will bring peace on this earth (**Read Isaiah 11:1-10**) It explains what the earth will be like **during the 1,000 year millennium** under Christ’s rein.
