Topic “Christ’s 2nd Coming”

Many verses reveal a righteous King to come

Jeremiah 23:5 KJV “Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.” This Old testament verse clearly states that God intends to set the Lord Jesus Christ up as King over the earth.

There have been many would be leaders wanting to take control of the world that rose and fell throughout history but God has in mind a PERFECT King for His promised Kingdom.

Romans 11:25-27 Paul tells us “all Israel shall be saved” because God will “take away their sins.” God promised Israel a Kingdom and there shall be a Kingdom. It will be established at the second coming.



Every Eye Shall See Him

The 2nd Event - of the Second Coming of Jesus Christ will be visible and every eye shall see Him coming in the clouds

We are told in Scripture that the Second Coming of Jesus Christ will be “with power and great glory.” In a triumphant return, Jesus Christ will come back as the **King of Kings and Lord of Lords**. On this day, the whole world will see, just who Jesus Christ really is.

Since the Kingdom wasn't established at the First Coming of Christ, it must be established at the Second Coming. God knew that the Jews would reject His Son; so He predetermined that Christ's shed Blood on Calvary would serve as an atonement for the sin of the world. This was God's plan all along - to come into the world and pay for the sins of all men (John 1:29; Rev. 13:8). So the First Coming was one of suffering and shame, but the Second Coming will be one of glory, honor, and praise (1 Pet. 1:10-12). The first time Jesus received a crown of thorns, but when He comes again He will have MANY crowns (Rev. 19:12). He was the “*lamb of God*” when He came the first time, but He will be the “*lion of the tribe of Judah*” the second time (Rev. 5:5). The First Coming gave Jesus Christ to the world, but the Second Coming will give the world to Jesus Christ! Just as David was chosen to be the king of Israel many years before he actually received the kingdom (1 Sam. 16), the Lord Jesus Christ has been chosen to take over the kingdoms of this world and rule as God's “KING OF KINGS” (Rev. 11:15; 19:16)

God cannot establish His Son in Israel as King of the Jews unless the Jews are living in Palestine, their promised homeland, so it is God's plan to restore the Jews to Palestine before the Second Coming of Christ. In 1948 Israel became an independent nation for the first time in many centuries! The Arabs have fought viciously to destroy Israel, but with no success. God wants His people IN PALESTINE (Amos 9:14-15), because the Lord Jesus Christ is coming soon. During the Six Day War of 1967, Israel even gained possession of the ancient temple site.
