Psalms 102:25-26 KJV "Of old hast thou laid the foundation of the earth: and the heavens are the work of thy hands. 26 They shall perish, but thou shalt endure: yea, all of them shall wax old like a garment; as a vesture shalt thou change them, and they shall be changed:"

The Bible says God will make all things new Revelation 21:5 KJV "And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful."

### A New Heaven & Earth

**Isaiah 65:17 KJV** "For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into mind."

**Isaiah 66:22 KJV** "For as the new heavens and the new earth, which I will make, shall remain before me, saith the LORD, so shall your seed and your name remain."

**Rev 22:3 KJV** "And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him:" **And there shall be no more curse**: There shall be no more any thing that looks like the curse upon the first paradise. **Zechariah 14:11 KJV** says "And men shall dwell in it, and there shall be no more utter destruction; but Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited."

-- and his servants shall serve him: In these words, our employment and our happiness in a state of blessedness are expressed; but what in particular our employment shall be, and wherein it shall consist, it is impossible now to know.
