

Topic >> The Resurrection on Earth from Adam & Eve to the Tribulation Saints at Christ's Coming!

Matthew 25:34 KJV "Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:"

John 11:24-25 KJV "Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day. 25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:"

Resurrection <u>on Earth</u> of all the "Just" Since the Beginning of the World (Adam to the Tribulation Saints)

1st Corinthians 15:20-22 KJV "But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept. 21 For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. 22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive." Thus, Christ is identified as the man who brings resurrection to mankind in contrast to Adam who, through sin brought death to mankind.

1st Corinthians 15:23 KJV <u>"But every man in his own order:</u> Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are <u>Christ's at his coming.</u>"

Christ's own resurrection was the first permanent resurrection unto righteousness. One could say that Christ's resurrection effectively broke open the gates of death making it possible for His followers to also follow Him into their own permanent resurrections unto righteousness. The resurrections of His followers is said to take place at the 2nd coming in two parts. The Rapture of the Body of Christ to Heaven, then the resurrection of the Old Testament Saints to Earth at the end of the trubulation. Then is the start of the 1,000 year Millennium, where Satan is put into the bottomless pit during this time.

Matthew 24:40-41 KJV "Then shall two be in the field; the one **shall be taken**, and the other left. 41 Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one **shall be taken**, and the other left." Many think these verses in Matthew refer to the Rapture but they do not. They refer to this time when Christ lands on the earth. The reference is <u>as in the days of Noah</u>

Matthew 24:37 KJV "But as the days of Noe (Noah) were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be."

Matthew 24:39 KJV "And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be." > In Noah's time the ones taken away were the ones taken to eternal pumishment. Likewise in matt 24:40-41 taken away to punishment

Revelation 20:4 KJV "And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years".
