## **Topic >> The Shed Blood of Jesus Christ – is the only thing that can save us from Hell**

Prophesying of the Messiah's conception and construct in the womb, Jeremiah said in Jeremiah 31:22b KJV "for the LORD hath created a new thing in the earth, A woman shall compass a man" (meaning will "surround" a man)

Rev 1:5 KJV "And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood"

John 1:14 KJV "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth."

Ephesians 2:13 KJV "But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ."



## Jesus Christ - Fully Man and Fully God

Jesus of Nazareth's story is <u>not</u> of man becoming God, but rather, God coming in a human body – the 'divine life' putting on or being clothed with a human 'body of flesh'... that He might die our death! While Mary herself was conceived of her human father, Jesus was conceived of the Spirit of the life of His Father God... then to be "born of a woman."

Mary's human blood did not touch or taint Jesus' 'Royal Blood.'

It's quite surprising to most of us that the a <u>human mother's own blood</u> <u>never enters the child's blood system</u> at any point. **Mother and child do** <u>not</u> <u>share the same blood!</u> The two lives of mother and child are separate and distinct because <u>each individual's</u> "<u>life</u> of their fathers is <u>in</u> the <u>blood.</u>" The mother's blood and the baby's <u>blood</u> do not touch, they are different individual lives, persons... <u>different souls having an individual life.</u>

Mary received the sin-nature of her father, as all humans do. Thankfully, in the conception of Jesus of Nazareth, Mary's human *blood-life* was <u>not</u> Jesus' *blood-life...* since He was born in the flesh of God His Father. Mary then "surrounded" and nourished baby Jesus in the womb, while the Spirit-life of God was in Jesus' 'Royal Blood'... was separate and distinct from Mary's blood life.

Jesus sacrificed His 'Royal Blood' and life for mankind on the cross...the Divine 'Royal Blood' that He shed was <u>not</u> simple human blood and life – it did <u>not</u> come from His human mother Mary or sourced in the life of fallen sinful mankind in any way. Jesus' blood contained His actual Spirit-life.

Only the 'Royal Blood' of the "Son of Man," Jesus of Nazareth, was <u>pure and thus qualifed to redeem sinful mankind</u> since His precious 'Royal Blood' was not of or related to any human person who had sinned (i.e.Adam, or His human mother). Only innocent Jesus Christ was free of sinful acts and thus qualified to "take away the sins of the world" by which all men are reconciled to God through faith in His Shed Royal Blood.
