



If you choose light > You Must Before the cross of Christ, mankind was divided into two groups: Jews and Gentiles, a distinction caused by the covenants God had made for Israel alone with Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and their descendants through Moses (Ex. 33:16; Lev. 20:24,26; Deut. 4:7-8; 1 Chr. 17:21,22; Psa. 147:19,20; Eph. 2:12).

> There are three divisions of mankind: Jews, Gentiles, and the Church (1 Cor. 10:32). It is absolutely essential to understand that these three groups exist side-by-side in today's world, and salvation is available to both Jews and Gentiles by the mystery of Grace, revealed to the Apostle Paul. The "free gift" to those who believe in Christ's death on the cross for the payment of sins and that He was buried and rose again on the third day according to the Scriptures. God did not bring Gentiles under the Jewish law, but now offers both Jews and Gentiles grace and peace in our present age of Grace. God has "broken down the middle wall of partition between (Jew and Gentile). That the Mosaic law was never intended for Gentiles and is not applicable to the church is clear; it was "abolished" by Jesus Christ. He said: "Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled" (Matthew 5:17,18). Far from teaching that the law would always be in force, Christ declared that it would pass away when it was fulfilled, and that He had come to fulfill it. His life, death, burial, and resurrection accomplished this fulfillment and made possible the mystery "the Church" whereby those in the church are "justified by faith without the deeds of the law" (Romans 3:21-30).
