Topic >> In Light or Darkness

Which Environment would you prefer to spend your eternity in?

1. Jesus being “the light of the world” means the world has no other light than Him. It is Jesus Christ or darkness.

2. It means therefore, that all the world and everyone in it needs Jesus Christ as their light.

The Lord Jesus Christ – The Light of the World

John 8:23 KJV “And he said unto them, Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world.”

John 14:6 KJV “Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”

Salvation is an operation of and a gift of God. It is not the “things” that we do that will get us to heaven. Our “works” are as filthy rags (Isaiah 64.6)

Salvation is by faith, when we believe and trust that Jesus Christ died on the cross to pay for our sins was buried and rose again

Jesus said in John 8:24 KJV “I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.”

Physical light is necessary for physical life. The earth would certainly change very rapidly if there was no longer any sunlight. Plants will never move away from the light—they are drawn to the light.

In the same way, spiritual light is necessary for spiritual life, and this can be a simple test of our standing in Christ. The believer will always tend toward spiritual things; he will always tend toward fellowship, prayer, the Word of God, and so on. The unbeliever always does the opposite because light exposes his evil, and he hates the light.

John 3:19 KJV “And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.”

John 1:1-5 KJV “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 The same was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. 4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men. 5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.”

The first few verses of John chapter 1 tell us that **Jesus Christ is the “Word” “and the Word was God”**
