Acts is where Israel fell in chapter 7 and is the transition from the Law of Israel to Apostle Paul's Grace of today. I would also, recommend going through the book of Romans in the Bible study section of our website (as it is Grace doctrine) and additional studies as well as videos. Please use the King James Bible, as it is God's Word to us in English. Follow along with your Bible with all the Bible verses that the Pastors quote in the video's. Ephesians 3:9 KJV "And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:"

Paul was beheaded in Rome after thirty or forty years of delivering God's message of the "Gospel of Grace" to the Gentiles.
