


Topic > Saul on the road to Damascus Meets The Risen LORD JESUS CHRIST & is appointed the Apostle to the Gentiles

Acts 9:6 KJV “And he (Saul) trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do.”

Here was Saul the **BLASPHEMER** which was an unpardonable sin against the Holy Spirit in Israel's law, gets to be the first person to get saved under Grace by the Gospel of Grace when the Risen Christ introduced it and appointed Saul (who) becomes Paul the **Apostel to the Gentiles**.

So if anybody in this Dispensation of Grace is wondering if they have committed the unpardonable sin and God will not save them

There is their answer – **there is no such thing as an unpardonable sin in this present Dispensation of Grace.**

Paul - the Apostle to the Gentiles

Paul's Spirit-inspired claims for the distinctive character of his Apostleship

Romans KJV 11:13: “For i speak to you Gentiles, inasmuch as i am the apostle of the Gentiles: I magnify mine office”.

Galatians KJV 1:11,12: “But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. 12 for i neither received it of man, neither was i taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.”

Ephesians KJV 3:1-3: “For this cause, i paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles, 2 if ye have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God, which is given me to you-ward: 3 how that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery”

Colossians KJV 1:25: “...I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfill the word of god”.

Ist Timothy KJV 2:5-7: “For there is one God, and one Mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; 6 who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time. 7 whereunto i am ordained a preacher, and an apostle (i speak the truth in christ, and lie not); a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and verity.”

Titus KJV 1:2,3: “In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie; promised before the world began; 3 but hath in due times manifested his word through preaching which is committed unto me, according to the commandment of god our saviour.”

Acts 26:11 KJV “And I punished them oft in every synagogue, and **compelled them to blaspheme**; and being exceedingly mad against them, I persecuted them even unto strange cities.”

The above verse describes “Saul” the **law keeping Pharise** in his persuit to persecute all followers of Jesus Christ that he could find and put them in jail. **Then he had a change of mind** when he met the Risen Savior JESUS CHRIST on the way to Demascus.

From being **exceedingly mad** against the followers of Christ – **to becoming Paul the Apostle to the Gentiles** – “**The Grace of Christ**” makes quite a change
