Verse of the day:

Isaiah 53:7 KJV "He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth."

Jesus Christ offered himself freely to suffer and die for us, and offered no defence of Himself in any way. He was oppressed and afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth, not even so much as to plead for His own innocence.

Bible passage: The book of Isaiah which was written about 700 years before the time of Jesus, the prophet Isaiah spoke of a son who would be called "Mighty God" and "Eternal Father." Isaiah also indicated that this son would reign on the throne of King David and that this reign would be everlasting - (Isaiah 9:6-7).

Close to one-third of the Bible is prophecy - history written in advance. God has foretold the future in the Bible and fulfills His prophecies in it. That sets the Bible apart from any book in the world. God declares in the beginning what the end would be.
