Romans 5:9 KJV “Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.”

The Roman Scourge also called a flagellum, was a short whip made of two or three leather (ox-hide) thongs or ropes connected to a handle. The leather thongs were knotted with several small pieces of metal, usually zinc and iron, attached at various intervals. Scourging would quickly remove the skin. Isaiah 52:14 suggests that the Romans beat Jesus so brutally that people were appalled to look at Him. After 40 lashes - “his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:” He basically was unrecognizable after that beating. Christ knew the beating He would have to endure before He created the world.

The Six illegal Trials of Jesus Christ

There were six trials that were conducted the night before Jesus was crucified. All of these proceedings were illegal, based on the rule of law in effect at the time these events took place.

1st illegal procedure - Before Annas, the High Priest (John 18:13). He was arrested and tried at night, which was illegal. “**A capital offense must be tried during the day and suspended at night.**” [6] -Mishna.

2nd illegal procedure - Before Caiaphas the High Priest and son-in-law of Annas (John 18:24). When Jesus was brought before Caiaphas, He was being judged by a solitary agent. **Caiaphas, as the High Priest, was not allowed to examine anyone who had been accused of a capital crime—by himself.**


3rd illegal procedure - Before the Sanhedrin (John 10:33). Accused of Blasphemy, the Sanhedrin itself originated the charges against Him “**The Sanhedrin could not originate charges; it could only investigate those brought before it**”

4th illegal procedure - Before Pilate (Matthew 27:2). No session of any court could transpire before the morning offering. “**The morning sacrifice was offered at the dawn of day. The Sanhedrin was not to assembly until the hour after that time.**”

5th illegal procedure - Before Herod (Luke 23:11-12). Jewish law required that no legal proceeding should be conducted on the day before the Sabbath. **In cases of capital crime, no trial could be commenced on Friday or the day previous to any holiday.**

6th illegal procedure Before Pilate (Mark 15:14-15). The entire trial of Jesus for a capital crime which resulted in His death by crucifixion—took just 24 hours. **According to Jewish law, Jesus could be accused on the first day; but if He should be found guilty and condemned to death, He could not be executed until the following day**
