G GRACE

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Topic >> "The Shed blood of Jesus Christ cleansed us from all our sin."

1st Corinthians 1:17 KJV "For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect." (Paul's words)

Why then in this Dispensation of Grace do Churches think that Baptism by water is so important. – What they are missing is that when we are saved, we are baptized into the body of Christ this is not a water Baptism. It is an operation of God where God baptizes believers into the body of Christ where we are "sealed" with the HOLY SPIRIT of promise.

"Grace" to the Gentiles like what the Apostle Paul introduced was never seen in the Bible before and where both Jews and Gentiles were saved the same way.

Going **back to Israel's works program**? <u>Which is another</u> <u>gospel</u>. (Galatians 1:6) in our "Grace" age is not a good idea! Apostle Paul's Distinctive Gospel was Preaching the Cross - That Christ died for our sins was buried and rose from the dead on the third day.

1st Corinthians 15:1-4 KJV "Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; 2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; 4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:"

The twelve Apostles nor any other writers in the Bible had ever preached a gospel like this before. It was unique to the Apostle Paul and so different than Israel's works program that the Jews took counsel to kill Paul. Acts 9:23

Paul's gospel of **faith PLUS nothing** for salvation was a "**stumbling block**" for the Jews of the Jerusalem church and the 12 Apostles who preached circumcision and keeping the Mosaic Law. **God did not reveal the message of Grace to the 12 Apostles or Israel**, <u>and they did not understand it</u>.

This also seems to be a "**stumbling block**" for <u>most churches today</u> that go back to Israel's program and take what they like and add it to Apostle Paul's Dispensation of "grace" <u>which is faith plus nothing and make salvation</u> into a work - <u>Contrary to Paul's simple "Grace" message</u>.

Which is believe, and trust in Christ exclusively that He died for our sins on the cross. That He was buried and rose again on the third day. **GOD KNOWS WHEN YOU BELIEVE** and at that **moment** you are sealed with the **HOLY SPIRIT**.

If you do something for your salvation (**no matter how small**) it is no longer by faith. <u>Believe and Trust by faith</u> is the only thing that qualifies as faith.

The "Moment" we believe Jesus Christ paid for our sins we are "SEALED" with the Holy Spirit

Jesus speaking: John 15:13 KJV "Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends"



Galatians 1:1 KJV "Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;)"

Romans 11:13 KJV "For I speak to you Gentiles, inasmuch as I am the apostle of the Gentiles, I magnify mine office:"

The <u>risen Jesus Christ</u> introduced "Grace" <u>through the Apostle Paul</u> (who was Saul of Tarsus the enemy of Jesus Christ and the 12 Apostles)
