**God had separated Israel** from the Gentiles, to be His representatives on earth and **For a Gentile to be saved** he had to become as a Jew.

After the cross and the stoning of Stephen, God temporary set Israel aside and introduced **Grace through the Apostle Paul**,

Ephesians 2:14 KJV "For he is our peace, who hath made <u>both one</u>, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us;" Between Israel and the Gentiles

& has enabled us to be **saved** "without the works" of the Law.

## Christ Came to Die - So we Could Live

Jesus Christ was **born of a virgin** [Mary] approximately **700 years after Isaiah prophesied** in **Isaiah 7:14** that this would take place.


